Hoban is committed to making Catholic education available to an economically, academically and ethnically diverse student population. The Brothers of Holy Cross founded Hoban as an all-boys high school in 1953. In 1973, the school became coed. In 1976, the lay Board of Directors assumed major governance responsibilities. The Board continues to work with the Brothers, who now sponsor the school.

RANK IN CLASS

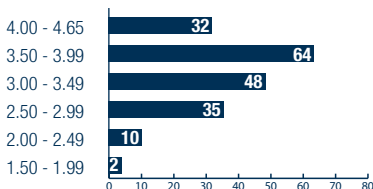
